RESOLUTION NO. 2608

A RESOLUTION NAMING A TRAIL IN TROUTDALE AS THE "CH'AK-CH'AK TRAIL"

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

- Construction is commencing to complete remaining segments of a public multi-use trail from NE Harlow Road along the Columbia River levee north and west to the western Troutdale city limits.
- 2. Troutdale has a strong and proud tradition of honoring and remembering local history, including in the selection of names for public places and amenities.
- 3. The adopted Parks Master Plan identifies a goal of increased involvement in the planning, design, and decision-making processes by Indigenous People in Troutdale's Parks & Recreation systems.
- 3. The Parks Master Plan additionally recommends improved wayfinding in Troutdale's trail systems.
- 4. The City desires to give the trail a name that honors and remembers the history and culture of the Troutdale area's Indigenous People and that is significant to local Native American communities, and therefore consulted with a member of the Confederated Tribes of Grande Ronde and expert in Chinook history & language in the trail name selection process.
- 5. With the help of said consultant, The Parks Advisory Committee has recommended the name "Ch'ak—Ch'ak" for the subject Trail. This term means Bald Eagle in the Chinuk Wawa language.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. The trail shown in Attachment A herewith shall henceforth be named the Ch'ak Ch'ak Trail.

Section 2. This Resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.
