

RESOLUTION NO. 2485

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH MULTNOMAH COUNTY FOR COST SHARING OF THE STARK STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This is the final phase of a multi-phased project that has been funded with federal transportation monies, and through cost sharing between the City of Troutdale and Multnomah County. Both share in the proposed street, sidewalk, curb and gutter, and bike lane improvements to Stark Street, between the intersection of Stark Street at SW 257th Ave, and eastward to the intersection of S. Troutdale Road (approximately one mile in length).
2. The Intergovernmental Agreement between the State of Oregon (acting as the agent for the Federal Transportation Administration), the City and the County completes a series of fish friendly bridge and culvert improvements performed in recent years by finishing the projects surface improvements.
3. This project will improve traffic and pedestrian safety and mobility on an important transportation corridor for Troutdale residents and businesses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to sign the Intergovernmental Agreement attached as Exhibit A to the Staff Report.

Section 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
