

RESOLUTION NO. 2488

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH MULTNOMAH COUNTY FOR COMMUNITY RESOURCE DEPUTY SERVICES PROVIDED THROUGH THE MULTNOMAH COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE.

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City Council approved an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) for Contracted Law Enforcement Services from the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) on March 24, 2015 via adopted Resolution No. 2278.
2. That through the IGA the MCSO has provided quality contracted law enforcement services to the City at a substantially lower cost to the taxpayers, has established a successful contract relationship, and desire to continue and build upon this existing partnership.
3. That the City desires to increase the services obtained from the MCSO to improve and support livability in Troutdale through the dedicated duties of a Community Resource Deputy (CRD), which the MCSO is willing to provide.
4. That the IGA for CRD services will provide enhanced sense of police presence within the City, addresses citizen concerns, and improves the safety and welfare of residents and visitors.
5. That the parties agree that the IGA enables the sharing resources and voids unnecessary duplication of staff, equipment, and training and will continue to promote efficiency and effectiveness in local government administration and service delivery.
6. That by the authority granted in Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 190.110, units of local governments may enter into Intergovernmental Agreements (IGA) for the performance of any or all functions and activities that a party to the agreement, its officers, or agents may have the authority to perform.
7. That the City and County desire to enter into an IGA to provide for CRD services as requested, and it is in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1. That the City enter into an IGA with Multnomah County to provide a law enforcement deputy to perform the duties of a Community Resource Deputy as requested, and hereby approves the IGA in substantial conformity with Exhibit A of the Staff Report the “*Intergovernmental Agreement Contract Number TROUTDALE-MCSOCD.*”

Section 2. Designates Ray Young, City Manager or Erich Mueller, Finance Director (each a “City Official”) or a designee of the City Official, to act on behalf of the City, and without further action by the City Council the City Official is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to sign the IGA on behalf of the City, and any and all other required and necessary documents to implement the intent of the agreement.

Section 3. The City Official is hereby authorized to execute, acknowledge and deliver the IGA in substantial conformity with Exhibit A of the Staff Report, including any other supporting and implementing documents, and to take any other action as may be advisable, convenient, necessary, or appropriate to give full force and effect to the terms and intent of the IGA, and the execution thereof by any such City Official shall be conclusive as to such determination.

Section 4. Further, consistent with intent of the IGA, and in the best interest of the City, the City Official is authorized to determine, execute, acknowledge and deliver any subsequent addendums, extensions, revisions, modification, or successor documents of the IGA, and the execution thereof by any such City Official shall be conclusive as to such determination.

Section 5. The Finance Director is authorized to disburse funds, subject to annual appropriations, as necessary to fulfill the IGA obligations, and is further directed to implement all such actions necessary to ensure budgetary compliance.

Section 6. Upon adoption this Resolution shall be effective February 1, 2020.
