

RESOLUTION NO. 2417

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH MULTNOMAH COUNTY FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM AND THE HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM FOR PROGRAM YEARS 2019-2022.

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development funds Community Development Block Grant and HOME Investment Partnership Programs, which provide needed funding primarily for low and moderate income residents.
2. An Urban County consortium consisting of unincorporated Multnomah County, Fairview, Maywood Park, Wood Village, Lake Oswego, and Troutdale was formed in 1984 to implement these programs.
3. Participation in that consortium must be renewed periodically, and the current agreement was scheduled to terminate on June 30, 2018.
4. The City of Troutdale desires to continue its participation in the consortium.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to sign an Intergovernmental Agreement, which is in substantial conformity to that which is attached to the Staff report as Exhibit "A", with Multnomah County for the Community Development Block Grant Program and the HOME Investment Partnership Program for Program Years 2019-2022.

Section 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
