

RESOLUTION NO. 2418

A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE CITY OF TROUTDALE'S ELIGIBILITY TO RECEIVE FISCAL YEAR 2018-2019 STATE SHARED REVENUES.

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That ORS 221.760 provides as follows:

The officer responsible for disbursing the funds to cities under ORS 323.455, 366.785 to 366.820 and 471.805 shall, in the case of a city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial census, disburse such funds only if the city provides four or more of the following services:

- 1) Police protection
- 2) Fire protection
- 3) Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
- 4) Sanitary sewer
- 5) Storm sewers
- 6) Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
- 7) One or more utility services

2. That City officials recognize the desirability of assisting the state officer responsible for determining the eligibility of cities to receive such funds in accordance with ORS 221.760.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1. That the City of Troutdale hereby certifies that it currently provides the following four or more municipal services enumerated in Section 1, ORS 221.760:

- Police protection
- Fire protection
- Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
- Sanitary sewer
- Storm sewers
- Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
- Water utility services

Section 2. That the Finance Director and Budget Officer is authorized and directed to take all steps necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution including transmitting a certified copy of this resolution to the State of Oregon, Department of Administrative Services to establish the City's eligibility for state shared revenues.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
